Between 2023 and 2025, Calgary's tech ecosystem added [\\$6.7 billion in value](#) to the Calgary economy, a growth of 13 per cent — in contrast to a 14 per cent average decline globally.

Tech talent hub in North America

Calgary ranked among the top 20 North American cities in [CBRE's 2025 Tech Talent report](#) and led the continent in tech talent growth for the second consecutive year, with a 61 per cent increase recorded from 2021 to 2024.

For startup creation

The University of Calgary has further solidified the city's innovation leadership, ranking first in Canada for startup creation for three consecutive years as of 2024.



Our momentum and growth over the past five years has been unprecedented. Calgary must capitalize on this and continue doubling down on its competitive advantages by fostering innovation-driven economic growth. The innovation strategy aims to establish an ecosystem of interconnected nodes across the city to provide vital infrastructure, resources, and collaboration opportunities for emerging businesses, ensuring Calgary remains at the forefront of technological advancement.



OUR VISION

We aspire to be the innovation capital of Canada.

Calgary has seen remarkable growth in not only its innovation ecosystem but the diversification of its economy including sectors like aerospace, creative industries, life sciences and agriculture. If we continue on this trajectory, Calgary can **become the innovation capital of Canada.**

To do so, we need to focus on **adoption of new and emerging technologies** across all sectors, and accelerate research and cross- pollination between startups, research institutes and large corporates in our right-to-win sectors.

In Calgary we see this sector focus coming to fruition through **nodes – concentrations of critical sector-specific innovation supports** - across the city. Each node will be connected to the other nodes around the city. This means innovators in Calgary will have an established roadmap to guide them from startup to scaleup with access to the assets and resources they need to thrive. Structuring our innovation ecosystem will also allow for better identification of investment opportunities, increasing capital attraction for Calgary. Our innovation strategy builds off innovation districts seen in other cities and takes this concept to the next level.

We aim to create over 187,000 jobs over the next 10 years, which we expect to contribute over \$28 billion in economic activity by 2034.

A node is a dense concentration of sector-specific innovation supports which have developed across Calgary. A node is not one building but a collection of resources, spaces and assets that together drive innovation. A node is connected to other Nodes across Calgary.

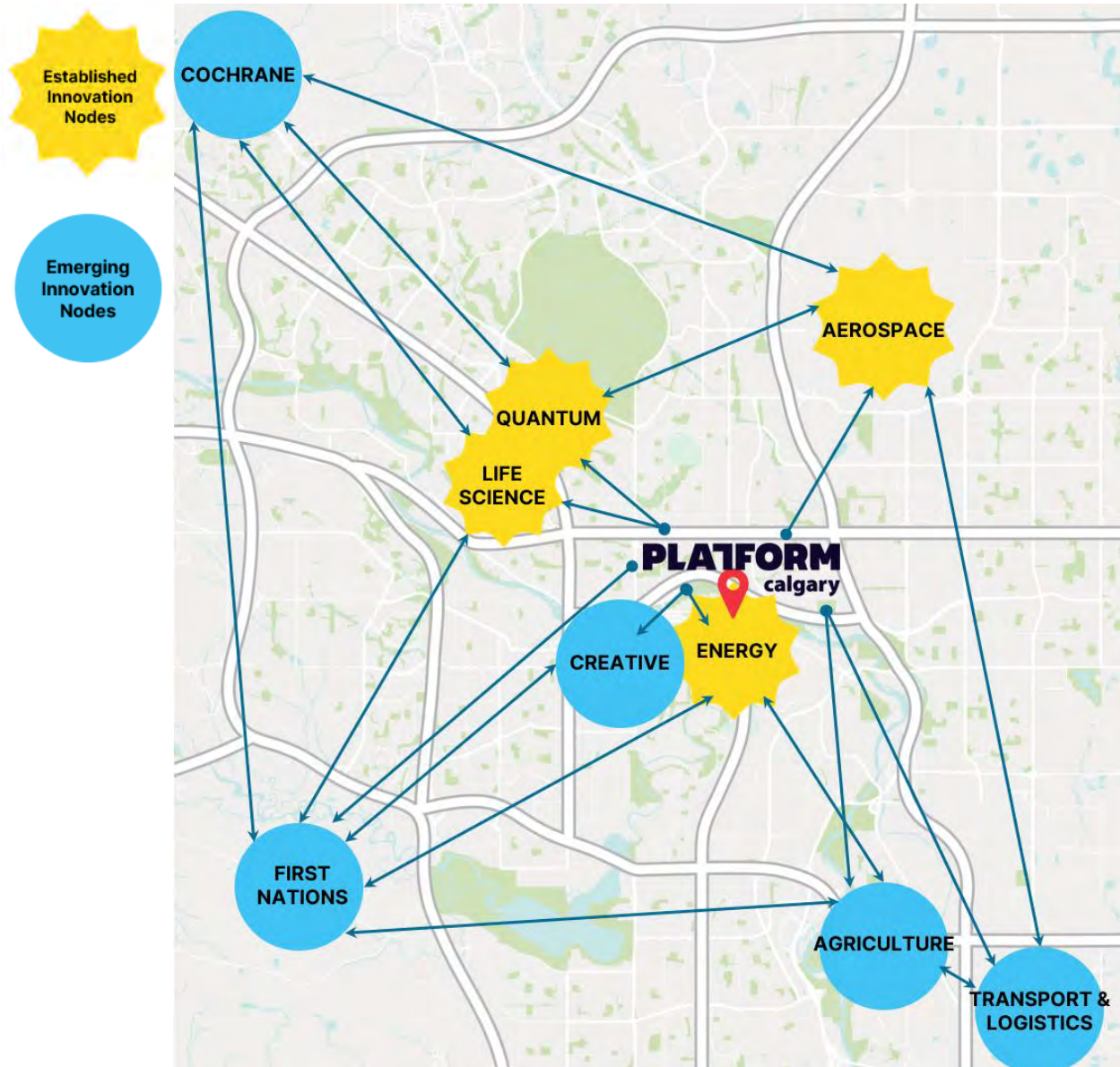

CONNECTING THE NODES



The Innovation Strategy aims to establish multiple nodes across the city. We are currently working to establish seven nodes across all quadrants of the city, with Platform as a central on-ramp into the network as startups move to scaleup.

Once established, these nodes will not exist in isolation. They will share resources and supports build a connected network of nodes and support the growth of companies and sectors across the city.



STRATEGIC GOALS

GOAL 1

ESTABLISH SECTOR-SPECIFIC INNOVATION NODES ACROSS CALGARY

Calgary's innovation strategy is founded on the establishment of nodes across the city.

OBJECTIVES

- 1 Identify nodes in our right-to-win sectors critical for innovation across Calgary.
- 2 Assess innovation resources in each node.
- 3 Strengthen nodes by assessing gaps in resources and support establishment of resources within each node.

- Once nodes are established, assess and identify future sub-
- 4 sectors that could be strengths for Calgary.





STRATEGIC GOALS

GOAL 2

LAUNCH AN INNOVATION ROADMAP

The intent of the strategy is to create better navigation within Calgary's innovation ecosystem. From ideation to unicorn, entrepreneurs, scale-ups and large corporates can use resources such as training, networking opportunities, office space, access to capital providers, professional services and a peer support network.

OBJECTIVES

- 1** Identify 'innovation champions' to adopt the vision and act as liaisons between businesses and the innovation ecosystem, helping people navigate the system and gain access to the resources they need.
- 2** Connect nodes to our innovation champions.
- 3** Establish on-ramping supports for businesses into the ecosystem at all levels of development.
- 4** Connect resources and supports in the nodes to each other.



STRATEGIC GOALS

GOAL 3

ENHANCE THE IMPACT OF OUR INNOVATION ECOSYSTEM

Our strategy extends beyond establishing nodes, we will leverage all resources across the city to enhance outcomes for our innovation community.

OBJECTIVES

- 1** Support innovation in our surrounding municipalities, leveraging regional economic development efforts to scale the size of opportunities.
- 2** Focus on a comprehensive IP strategy to support home-grown innovations.
- 3** Expand regulatory sandboxes to incentivize prototyping and experimentation across all sectors.
- 4** Structure the innovation ecosystem to make wayfinding easier for both startups and investors.
